**IRISH NEWSPAPER ARCHIVES LTD.:** The launch of the Irish Newspapers Online Research Archive has been delayed due to upgrading the project to a new OCR (optical character recognition) engine. In a brief message dated 6 August 2004, Jonathan Martin advised that "the project had been delayed by two months due to the OCR engine upgrade. The following papers will be fully indexed and display on our site.

- The Irish Independent, 1904 – current year,
- Freeman's Journal, 1763 – 1924,
- The Nation, 1842 – 1893,
- The Angle-Celt, 1846 – current year,
- The Meath Chronicle, 1904 – current year.

Terry, at the time of launch however, we estimate the Irish Independent will be the only title available fully OCR'ed, the OCR processing will be concurrent on the other titles at the time of launch. That means that it may be two months from live launch before the Freeman's Journal is totally OCR'ed and so forth with the other papers. However all the titles will be available just not word searchable (indexed) at launch.

Newspapers which will be available shortly launch include:

- The Tuam Herald, 1882 – current year,
- The Drogheda Independent 1885 – 1891 & 1988 – current year,
- The Sunday Independent, 1905 – current year.

Since we last talked, we have secured The Kerryman newspaper, 1904 – current year and I feel once the website is up and running, the Irish Times will hopefully commit to the website". End of quote. **CIVIL REGISTRATION IN IRELAND:** Registration of non-Catholic marriages in Ireland began on 01 April 1845. Civil registration of Catholic marriages and all births and deaths began on 01 January 1864. Please note that the place listed in the civil registration index is the name of the registration district, not the name of the civil parish. If all you know is the name of your ancestor's county of origin and you want to know the names of the registration districts for that county, see Civil Registration Districts of Ireland which has three parts. Part I contains maps showing registration districts. Part II is an alphabetical index of districts that shows the county for each district. Part III is a list of counties that shows the districts in each county. It is on fiche 6036472 in the FHL.

The microfilmed Civil Registration Indexes are at the Parramatta L. D. S. Family History Centre, 169 Pennant Street (opposite Isabella Street) North Parramatta NSW 2151 and in each state capital throughout Australia. In Dublin these indexes are available at the Dublin City Library & Archive, 138-144 Pearse Street, Dublin 2 with extended opening hours, Monday to Thursday 10.00 am – 8.00 pm and Friday & Saturday 10.00 am – 5.00 pm. ## IRISH POST OFFICES:

This is a list of **Post Offices in Ireland in 1871** continued from Vol. 6, No. 7, July 2004. When the name of one place stands alone in the following list, it shows that the place is a Head Office; when two places are mentioned the Office at the first is a Sub-Office, and that at the second is the Head Office. When the name of a place is followed by the name of a county, in parentheses and *italics*, the Office is a Railway Sub-Office, or a Sub-Office which receives its correspondence direct from a Travelling Office, instead of through a Post Town. Note that many of these Places are Unofficial Place-Names throughout Ireland. Note: Read the introduction in Vol. 6, No. 7, July 2004 for a full introduction.
