Registers of Prerogative and Diocesan Wills of Ireland, with Indexes, 1828-1839: The authors were The Commissioners for Inland Revenue Great Britain and Church of Ireland, Province of Armagh, Prerogative Court. These registers are on microfilm at the National Archives of Ireland, Bishop Street, Dublin.

These registers were prepared by the Inland Revenue Office for taxation purposes. They were presented to the Dublin Public Record Office (now NAD) in 1937. The information served as abstracts of wills which were destroyed in the 1922 Four Courts fire. The Prerogative Court of the Archbishop of Armagh and the Diocesan Courts under this court had original jurisdiction over probate of these wills. Abstracts include names of the deceased, the executor(s), sometimes the heirs, dates of the will and date of the probate, and value of the estate. These were filmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah in 1951 on 11 reels of 35 mm film as follows:
